Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Tuesday, March 22nd. The Mass intention is for: **For immigrant children in detention.**

By July 6, 2021, the latest figures available from CBP show that entries for fiscal year 2020 already have surpassed that number, with the agency logging over 93,500 unaccompanied minors and with a little less than three months left to go in the fiscal year... Pope Francis has deemed immigrant children "the most vulnerable group among migrants"... Many Catholic nonprofits throughout the United States, via organizations such as Catholic Charities and the U.S. Conference of Bishops' Migration and Refugee Services have been part of a network of faith groups active in caring for the minors in smaller, family-like settings and helping them until they eventually reach family.

Fourth Sunday of Lent. Today we hear one of the most beloved stories in the Gospel of Luke, Jesus' parable of the Prodigal Son. Reconciliation is a prominent theme. If you have not done so already, consider celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation and experience God's loving embrace and forgiveness.

Social Justice Lent 2022....Wednesday March 2 (Ash Wednesday)-April 16

Instead of giving something up for Lent this year, try walking a new step on the justice road every day. Each day of Lent we have a suggestion designed to encourage prayer, reflection, charity, and advocacy on social justice issues facing us today.

“Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?” Isaiah 58:6 ****Sundays are a day of rest and family time without an obligation.**

March 28th - April 2nd

Day 23) At every meal today consider all the steps required to put the food on your plate, from the planting of a seed to its arrival at the grocery store. Give thanks for God's creation and those who grow and harvest out food.

Day 24) Find out when your congressperson will next have a town hall or public meeting. Put it on your calendar. Think about amplifying the voices of those who are silenced or ignored.

Day 25) Read and reflect on the Right to Life article from Catholic Diocese of Salt Lake <https://joomla.dioslc.org/documents/government-liaison-peace-and-justice-ministry/catholic-social-teaching/166-the-right-to-life/file>

Day 26) Don't throw anything away today. Find a way to repurpose, recycle, or make do without using it instead. Consider the impact that your waste has on God's planet.

Day 27) Think about the needs of the refugees and immigrants entering our community. What can we do to welcome them? Contact Catholic Charities and request information about immigrant and refugee services. <https://www.catholiccharitiesusa.org/our-vision-and-ministry/immigration-refugee-services/>

Day 28) Open the Bible to the Gospels, choose a chapter from Matthew, Mark, Luke, or John, read it, and reflect on it or discuss it as a family. How does it speak to your daily life?
