

A Stewardship Moment

In today's Gospel, Jesus challenged the social structure of the Pharisees and teaches his hosts and their guests some profound lessons in humility. Pharisees maintained deep social divisions between who they considered "holy" and "unholy," rich and poor, honored and despised. They didn't invite someone to a banquet or dinner who couldn't reciprocate. And the lowly, the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind had no capacity to reciprocate. Good stewards realize that if they embrace a humility that allows them to be generous to those who cannot repay them, they give evidence of having the kind of heart that will enjoy the Lord's intimate friendship. This week let's reflect on our attitude towards those who cannot repay our generosity. What is the extent of our hospitality toward others? Are we generous with those who cannot repay us?

Los buenos corresponsables son conscientes de que si abrazan una humildad que les permita ser generosos con aquellos que no pueden corresponder, ellos dan evidencia de tener la bondad de corazón que disfrutará la Amistad íntima con el Señor. Esta semana reflexionemos sobre nuestra actitud hacia quienes no pueden corresponder a nuestra generosidad. ¿Cuál es el alcance de nuestra hospitalidad hacia los demás? ¿Somos generosos con aquellos que no pueden pagarnos?

Most fulfilling for Nora is her work in worship—supporting choirs, providing voice coaching, guiding instrumentalists, and building music ministries that uplift and unify congregations. She is passionate about fostering meaningful musical worship experiences rooted in liturgical traditions by blending classical artistry with sacred leadership.

Classically trained in cello, piano, voice, theory, and composition, she integrates her musical expertise with a deep understanding of liturgical tradition. She confidently leads ensembles of all ages and skill levels. Nora is a recipient of numerous awards and scholarships, including the Leonard Bernstein Scholarship, and a prizewinner in international competitions. Through teaching, performing, and ministry, she hopes to inspire communities with music that nourishes both the heart and the spirit.

Let's Celebrate the Season of Creation, September 1 - October 4

What is the Season of Creation?

The Season of Creation begins on September 1, World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and ends on October 4, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology beloved by many Christian denominations. The Season of Creation is a time to renew our relationship with our Creator and all creation through celebration, conversion, and commitment together. During the Season of Creation, we join our sisters and brothers in the ecumenical family in prayer and action for our common home. Pope Francis made the Roman Catholic Church's warm welcoming of the season official in 2015. Throughout the month-long celebration, we come together in an annual ecumenical celebration of prayer and action for our common home.

What does our Catholic faith tell us about Creation?

Caring for creation is part of living out our Catholic faith. The Church, following the teachings of Jesus, throughout time has exhorted believers to work for the common good, which calls for dignifying life in all its forms, caring for our common home, and committing to the construction of more just, supportive, fraternal and peaceful societies. These are some ways to achieve what Pope Francis calls integral ecology in his teaching letter, the Encyclical Laudato Si' (2015). Often, when we speak of creation, it is related to nature, animals, landscapes, the sun, the moon, but we are also aware that the human being is the culmination of our Father's creative work, "God saw all he had made, and indeed it was very good." (Gen 1:31), the Sacred Scripture states. As Pope Francis wrote in Laudato Si', "Everyone's talents and involvement are needed to redress the damage caused by human abuse of God's creation". All of us can cooperate as instruments of God for the care of creation, each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and talents." (LS 14).

Celebremos el Tiempo de la Creación, del 1 de septiembre al 4 de octubre

¿Qué es el Tiempo de la Creación?

El Tiempo de la Creación comienza el 1 de septiembre, Jornada Mundial de Oración por el Cuidado de la Creación, y finaliza el 4 de octubre, festividad de San Francisco de Asís, santo patrono de la ecología, amado por muchas denominaciones cristianas. El Tiempo de la Creación es un momento para renovar nuestra relación con nuestro Creador y con toda la creación mediante la celebración, la conversión y el compromiso colectivo. Durante el Tiempo de la Creación, nos unimos a nuestros hermanos y hermanas de la familia ecuménica en oración y acción por nuestra casa común. El Papa Francisco oficializó la cálida bienvenida de la Iglesia Católica Romana a este tiempo en 2015. A lo largo de este mes de celebración, nos reunimos en una celebración ecuménica anual de oración y acción por nuestra casa común.

¿Qué nos dice nuestra fe católica sobre la Creación?

Cuidar la creación forma parte de vivir nuestra fe católica. La Iglesia, siguiendo las enseñanzas de Jesús, ha exhortado a los creyentes a trabajar por el bien común, lo que implica dignificar la vida en todas sus formas, cuidar la casa común y comprometerse con la construcción de sociedades más justas, solidarias, fraternas y pacíficas. Estas son algunas maneras de lograr lo que el Papa Francisco llama ecología integral en su carta magisterial, la Encíclica Laudato Si' (2015). A menudo, cuando hablamos de la creación, nos referimos a la naturaleza, los animales, los paisajes, el sol, la luna, pero también somos conscientes de que el ser humano es la culminación de la obra creadora de nuestro Padre: «Vio Dios todo lo que había hecho, y he aquí que era muy bueno» (Gn 1,31), afirma la Sagrada Escritura. Como escribió el Papa Francisco en Laudato Si': «Se necesitan los talentos y la implicación de todos para reparar el daño causado por el abuso humano a la creación de Dios. Todos podemos cooperar como instrumentos de Dios para el cuidado de la creación, cada uno según su propia cultura, experiencia, implicación y talentos». (LS 14).
