Social Justice Mass Intention

In a society that judges a person on the value of what he produces, the mentally ill person is easily seen merely as a burden on society. As Christians, then, we are called unceasingly to affirm their dignity as human beings made in the image and likeness of God and to recognize their value to the community. "It is everyone's duty to make an active response; our actions must show that mental illness does not create insurmountable distances . . . Indeed it should inspire a particularly attentive attitude." Pope John Paul II, International Conference for Health Care Workers, on Illness of the Human Mind, February 11, 1984.

Sixth Sunday of Easter. Philip understood very well Jesus' words: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." We learn of Philip's devotion to prayer, evangelizing and healing in the region of Samaria; made up of communities that would not be very receptive to the followers of Jesus. Philip is a model steward, living his discipleship day by day in the Lord without being obstructed by feelings of what cost his actions might entail. Good stewards summon the courage to proclaim the Lord and to serve Him by ministering to others. As an Easter people, eager to rejoice in the Lord, it is important to reflect on how we are living out our own commitment to discipleship.
