A Stewardship Moment

In today's Gospel Jesus offers his parable about last chances. The fig tree will have one last chance to bear fruit before it is cut down and destroyed. Good stewards realize that, like the fig tree, they are endowed with God-given gifts that are meant to "bear fruit" for God and neighbor. God has legitimate expectations of them. They also realize they do not know how much time they have left before the gardener returns for an accounting of their fruitfulness. How are we using our God-given gifts? How might we use our gifts to bear more fruit? The answer requires some urgency.

Ellos son también conscientes de que no saben cuánto tiempo les resta antes de que el hortelano regrese a pedirles cuentas de su productividad. ¿Cómo estamos usando los dones dados por Dios? ¿Cómo podríamos usar nuestros dones para dar más fruto? La respuesta requiere cierta urgencia.

Day 17) Fast from comparing yourself to others.

Day 19) Stop and think about everything that is imperfect—in you, in your loved ones, in the world. Pray the Serenity Prayer. (Google it!)

Day 22) Eat at a restaurant, or find a recipe, that is culturally different from your normal cuisine. Try something new. Learn about the culture and the country.

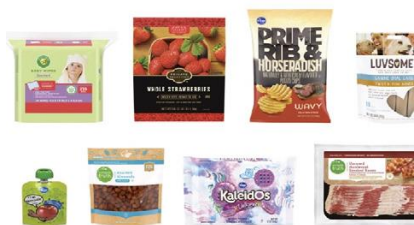

Terracycle's mission is to eliminate waste by partnering with individuals, businesses, and communities around the world on a journey toward a circular economy.

- Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.
