A Stewardship Moment

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus brings up the topic of the cross to his followers. They would not realize the cross was part of God's plan and was to be their legacy until after the Resurrection. Today's followers of Christ recognize they are stewards of his entire legacy, including his cross; that through their mutual sacrifices God's glory is revealed. They don't live their lives in Christ only when it is convenient for them. They make a decision to take up their cross and carry it, no matter what the cost. In the midst of the uncertain times we live in, what crosses do we bear in order to reveal God's glory?

Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Wednesday, August 26. The Mass intention is for: **Access to clean and safe water.**

Twenty years ago, the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace issued the document, "Water, an Essential Element for Life." It outlines the Catholic Church's position on water, stating that "The management of water and sanitation must address the needs of all, and particularly of persons living in poverty. Inadequate access to safe drinking water affects the well-being of over one billion persons and more than twice that number have no adequate sanitation. This all too often is the cause of disease, unnecessary suffering, conflicts, poverty and even death. This situation is characterized by countless unacceptable injustices."

... Catholic ethics on water also emphasizes the importance of managing it responsibly. This involves knowing about the interconnectedness of the natural world and the need to balance human needs with those of other species and ecosystems. Water resources should be used in a sustainable and just manner in order to ensure that future generations will have access to this vital resource. <https://www.chausa.org/news-and-publications/publications/health-progress/archives/summer-2023/ethics---water-shapes-our-connection-to-life>

Intenciones del Ministerio de Justicia Social

Está invitado a asistir y orar en la misa del miércoles 26 de agosto. La intención de la misa es por: **Acceso a agua limpia y segura.**

Hace veinte años, el Consejo Pontificio Justicia y Paz publicó el documento "El agua, elemento esencial para la vida". En él se expone la postura de la Iglesia Católica sobre el agua, afirmando que "la gestión del agua y del saneamiento debe atender a las necesidades de todos, y en particular de las personas que viven en la pobreza. El acceso insuficiente a agua potable afecta al bienestar de más de mil millones de personas, y más del doble de esa cifra carece de un saneamiento adecuado. Con demasiada frecuencia, esto es causa de enfermedades, sufrimientos innecesarios, conflictos, pobreza e incluso la muerte. Esta situación se caracteriza por innumerables injusticias inaceptables".

... La ética católica sobre el agua también subraya la importancia de gestionarla de manera responsable. Esto implica reconocer la interconexión del mundo natural y la necesidad de equilibrar las necesidades humanas con las de otras especies y ecosistemas.
