Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Thursday, July 3. The Mass intention is for: **The farms and farmers that grow our food.**

In Laudato Si the Holy Father emphasizes, “we ourselves are dust of the earth” (Gen 2:7); our very bodies are made up of her elements, we breathe her air and we receive life and refreshment from her waters. We are part of nature, included in it and thus in constant interaction with it. From conception to the moment of death, the life of every person is integrated with and sustained by the awesome panoply of natural processes. This calls for a reciprocal response on the part of humanity – to nourish and sustain the earth that in turn nourishes and sustains us.

Agriculture is the practice of this reciprocity. From the very beginning, the Creator asks us to till the earth and to keep it. And farming is a constant backdrop in the Bible. The language of Jesus is full of illustrations from agriculture — tending flocks, planting, harvesting, building granaries and paying workers. Jesus assumes his listeners understand and respect healthy agriculture. Intenciones del Ministerio de Justicia Social

Está invitado a asistir y orar en la misa del jueves 3 de julio. La intención de la misa es por: **Las granjas y los agricultores que cultivan nuestra comida.**

En Laudato Si, el Santo Padre enfatiza: «Somos polvo de la tierra» (Gn 2,7); nuestros cuerpos están hechos de sus elementos, respiramos su aire y recibimos vida y refrigerio de sus aguas. Somos parte de la naturaleza, estamos incluidos en ella y, por lo tanto, en constante interacción con ella. Desde la concepción hasta el momento de la muerte, la vida de cada persona se integra y se sustenta gracias a la asombrosa variedad de procesos naturales. Esto exige una respuesta recíproca por parte de la humanidad: nutrir y sostener la tierra, que a su vez nos nutre y nos sostiene.

La agricultura es la práctica de esta reciprocidad. Desde el principio, el Creador nos pide que cultivemos la tierra y la cuidemos. Y la agricultura es un tema recurrente en la Biblia. El lenguaje de Jesús está lleno de ejemplos de la agricultura: cuidar rebaños, plantar, cosechar, construir graneros y pagar a los trabajadores. Jesús asume que sus oyentes comprenden y respetan la agricultura sana.
