Stewardship Moment

Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel Jesus lays judgment on the scribes and Pharisees for the hypocritical way they lived out their faith. The criticisms he levies are all about the ways righteousness turns into self-righteousness, and how religious belief could turn into something that was more about elevating themselves than about what they could do for God or their neighbor. Good stewards know that discipleship means finding ways to serve, and searching for ways to be a servant—to live as a servant of Christ. When faith is authentically lived out in community everyone is enriched, and God is glorified. Reflect this week on how you live out your faith.

La demanda de productos del mar tiene un profundo impacto en las poblaciones de peces y los hábitats marinos en todo el mundo. Como resultado, algunas especies de peces que se encuentran comúnmente en los menús ahora están en grave peligro en estado silvestre. Los consumidores pueden tomar decisiones que sean más saludables para los océanos utilizando Seafood Watch en <https://www.seafoodwatch.org/>, que clasifica los productos del mar como "mejor opción", "buena alternativa" o "evitar", según los problemas que afectan a cada especie. La guía también permite a los usuarios compartir ubicaciones de restaurantes y mercados donde han encontrado productos del mar sostenibles.

Help salmon by using Seafood Watch

The demand for seafood profoundly impacts fish populations and marine habitats worldwide. As a result, some species of fish commonly found on menus are now severely imperiled in the wild. Consumers can make choices that are healthier for oceans by using the [Seafood Watch](https://www.seafoodwatch.org/) at <https://www.seafoodwatch.org/>, which ranks seafood as "best choice," "good alternative" or "avoid", based on issues affecting each species. The guide also lets users share locations of restaurants and markets where they've found sustainable seafood.

National Vocation Awareness Week

National Vocation Awareness Week (NVAW) is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promote vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations.

NVAW began in 1976 when the US Bishops designated the 28th Sunday of the year for NVAW. In 1997, this celebration was moved to coincide with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, in January. It has since been moved to the first full week in November.

During the month of November, the Vocations Ministry will post pictures on the Parish calendar in the narthex of the seminarians currently in the process of discernment and education in the Archdiocese of Portland. Each photo will include a QR code that can be scanned to learn more about each of the seminarians.

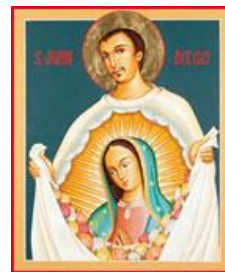
