A Stewardship Moment

Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary & Joseph. In today's second reading we listen to one of the most compelling exhortations for Christian living: "Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him" (Col 3:17). "Whatever you do" that means the whole of life is to be related to Christ Jesus. Everything in life, every activity, can become an act of glorifying the Lord. Good stewards commit even their daily routine to Christ: doing everything "in the name of the Lord." Perhaps it would be a good idea this week to memorize this marvelous verse and repeat it to yourself frequently. Make it part of your morning prayer each day.

Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. The encounter between God and Moses in today's first reading is awe-inspiring. God bestows three blessings upon Moses and directs him to extend those blessings to others: The Lord blesses you and keeps you. The Lord lets his face shine upon you and be gracious to you. The Lord looks upon you kindly and gives you peace. Good stewards realize these blessings are showered upon them in a unique and special way each time they receive the Eucharist, and exercising good stewardship of the Lord's blessings in this sacrament begins by receiving these gifts with profound gratitude. Perhaps it would be a good idea this week to memorize these marvelous blessings and repeat them to yourself frequently. Make them part of your morning prayer each day.

"Hagas lo que hagas", eso significa que toda la vida debe estar relacionada con Cristo Jesús. Todo en la vida, cada actividad, puede convertirse en un acto de glorificar al Señor. Los buenos corresponsables comprometen incluso su rutina diaria con Cristo: hacer todo "en el nombre del Señor". Quizás sea una buena idea esta semana memorizar este maravilloso verso y repetirlo con frecuencia. Hágalo parte de su oración matutina todos los días.

Solemnidad de la Santísima Virgen María, Madre de Dios. El encuentro entre Dios y Moisés en la primera lectura de hoy es una espléndida inspiración. Dios otorga tres bendiciones a Moisés y le dirige para extender esas bendiciones a otros. El Señor le bendice y le protege. El Señor deja brillar su rostro sobre usted, y es bondadoso con usted. El Señor cuida de usted amorosamente, y le da paz. Los buenos corresponsables son conscientes de que esas bendiciones son derramadas sobre ellos/as de una forma única y especial cada vez que reciben el sacramento de la Eucaristía, y ejercitar una buena corresponsabilidad de las bendiciones del Señor otorgadas en este sacramento se inicia por recibir estos dones con profunda gratitud. Tal vez sea una buena idea que esta semana memorice esas maravillosas bendiciones y las repita frecuentemente. Hágalas parte de su oración de la mañana, diariamente.
