Living the Corporal Works of Mercy during Lent

Let us continue to refresh our minds and hearts as we examine the Corporal Works of Mercy during this Lent. Let us walk with purpose, moving our faith into action.

Week 7 – March 30th – April 4th - Give alms to the poor/ clothed the naked

Giving alms has always been an important ministry to Christians. In the early Church, where the preferential love for the poor was universally acknowledged, communities made sure that all members had what they needed. Helping your neighbor was simply what was done.

A difference between today's almsgiving and that of previous generations is that we are so far removed from those we are giving to. Rarely do we even meet those our money is helping, much less have a relationship with them. We have lost a level of connection that in fact blesses the giver as much as the receiver. Knowing the poor as individuals — human beings made in the image and likeness of God, with names, personalities, gifts and talents — reminds us that they too have an inherent right to respect and dignity.

What can we do?

- Find a charity or organization that is meaningful to you and volunteer your time or donate.
- Many at St. Juan Diego support our St. Vincent DePaul Pantry, Faith Café, Family Promise, UGM Women and Children LifeChange program at Angela's House, or Catholic Charities. Get involved with the Social Justice Ministry to learn more.
- Pick up a rice bowl and fill it with your coins to support CRS (Catholic Relief Services).
- Skip the morning latte and put that money in the collection basket at church.

Semana 7 – 30 de marzo – 4 de abril – Dar limosna a los pobres / vestir a los desnudos

Dar limosna siempre ha sido un ministerio importante para los cristianos. En la Iglesia primitiva, donde el amor preferencial por los pobres era universalmente reconocido, las comunidades se aseguraban de que todos sus miembros tuvieran lo que necesitaban. Ayudar al prójimo era simplemente lo que se hacía.

Una diferencia entre la limosna de hoy y la de generaciones anteriores es que estamos muy lejos de aquellos a quienes damos. Rara vez conocemos a quienes ayuda nuestro dinero, y mucho menos tenemos una relación con ellos. Hemos perdido un nivel de conexión que, de hecho, bendice tanto al que da como al que recibe. Conocer a los pobres como individuos —seres humanos hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios, con nombres, personalidades, dones y talentos— nos recuerda que ellos también tienen un derecho inherente al respeto y la dignidad.
