Stewardship Moments

In today's second reading, Timothy is issued a strong directive: "Bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God." For the early Christians this could mean torture and execution. For most Christians today enduring hardship for the Gospel might include accepting ridicule or mockery, or the suggestion that we lack sophistication. Nevertheless, in his letters, Saint Paul is adamant that we should not be ashamed of being followers of Christ. Good stewards are not ashamed of their allegiance to Christ. They do not hide their faith. Reflect on this question: Are you willing to speak about following Christ Jesus no matter who your listeners happen to be?

Momentos de Corresponsabilidad

En la segunda lectura de hoy, Timoteo recibe una fuerte directiva: "Comparte conmigo los sufrimientos por la predicación del Evangelio, sostenido por la fuerza de Dios". Para los primeros cristianos, esto podría significar tortura y ejecución. Para la mayoría de los cristianos de hoy, las dificultades duraderas del Evangelio pueden incluir aceptar el ridículo o la burla, o la sugerencia de que carecemos de sofisticación. Sin embargo, en sus cartas, San Pablo insiste en que no debemos avergonzarnos de ser seguidores de Cristo. Los buenos corresponsables no se avergüenzan de su lealtad a Cristo. No esconden su fe. Reflexione sobre esta pregunta: ¿Está dispuesto a hablar sobre seguir a Cristo Jesús sin importar quiénes sean sus oyentes?

Please join us for the Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent starting February 24th at 6:00 pm, followed by a simple supper.



VATICAN CITY - In societies increasingly made up of people of different cultures and religions, people must learn the art of dialogue and reach out to others with respect and friendship, Pope Francis said. "Dialogue does not mean renouncing your identity" or "accepting compromises on faith and Catholic morals," the pope told members of the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue.... Pope Francis said modern societies are demonstrating fear of other religions, but also fear of any religion, which is another reason why followers of different faiths should meet, dialogue and work together to promote the common good and show others that faith makes positive contributions to society.

Day 13 Try a doodle prayer. Write the name of a person or situation for which you would like to pray. 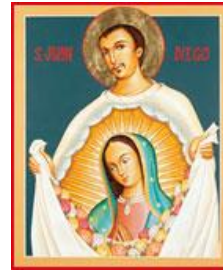
