A Stewardship Moment

The prophet Jeremiah minces no words in today's first reading: "Thus says the LORD: Cursed is the one who trusts in human beings ... whose heart turns away from the LORD." And the prophet's "beatitude" resembles that of Jesus' teaching in today's Gospel reading when he proclaims: "Blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose hope is the LORD." Good stewards understand that what the world values is not consistent with Gospel values. They realize that God has placed in their midst all the gifts, charisms, and resources needed to bring Christ to a world desperately in need of his loving presence. But to exercise good stewardship over God's gifts takes a great deal of trust. How does our stewardship reflect our trust in the Lord? What did we do today to give others hope in Christ Jesus?

Un Momento de Corresponsabilidad

El profeta Jeremías dice de manera muy directa en la primera lectura de hoy: "Así dice el SEÑOR: Maldito el hombre que confía en el hombre... mientras su corazón se aparta del SEÑOR." Y la "bienaventuranza" del profeta se asemeja a la de la enseñanza de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy cuando proclama: "Bendito es el hombre que confía en el SEÑOR, y en él tiene puesta su confianza." Los buenos corresponsables entienden que lo que el mundo valora no es coherente con los valores del Evangelio. Reconocen que Dios ha puesto en medio de ellos todos los dones, carismas y recursos necesarios para llevar a Cristo a un mundo que necesita desesperadamente de su amorosa presencia. Pero ejercitar una buena corresponsabilidad sobre los dones de Dios conlleva una gran cantidad de confianza. ¿Cómo refleja nuestra corresponsabilidad nuestra confianza en el Señor? ¿Qué hicimos hoy para dar a otros esperanza en Cristo Jesús?
