In our world and nation, many of our sisters and brothers live in poverty. The causes are complex, but the results are clear. They cannot find decent work, feed their families, educate their children, secure health care, or find adequate housing. Millions of children live in nations with too much debt and not enough development, in societies with deadly diseases and inadequate health care, in lands where conflict and corruption leave people without a place at the table. Millions of families cannot live in dignity because they lack the conditions worthy of human life. As Catholics, we must come together with a common conviction that we can no longer tolerate the moral scandal of poverty in our land and so much hunger and deprivation in our world. As believers, we can debate how best to overcome these realities, but we must be united in our determination to do so. Our faith teaches us that poor people are not issues or problems but sisters and brothers in God's one human family.

Millones de niños viven en naciones con demasiada deuda y sin suficiente desarrollo, en sociedades con enfermedades mortales y atención médica inadecuada, en tierras donde el conflicto y la corrupción dejan a las personas sin un lugar en la mesa. Millones de familias no pueden vivir dignamente porque carecen de las condiciones dignas de la vida humana.

Como católicos, debemos unirnos con la convicción común de que ya no podemos tolerar el escándalo moral de la pobreza en nuestra tierra y tanta hambre y privaciones en nuestro mundo. Como creyentes, podemos debatir cuál es la mejor manera de superar estas realidades, pero debemos estar unidos en nuestra determinación de hacerlo. Nuestra fe nos enseña que los pobres no son asuntos ni problemas, sino hermanos y hermanas en la única familia humana de Dios.

In 1986, a compassionate woman named Karen Olsen in New Jersey became aware of homeless families in her local area and decided she needed to do something about it. She started the nonprofit organization now called Family Promise. In 2016 here in the Beaverton area many people came out to support the beginnings of our local Family Promise affiliate. Since that time over 500 of our local neighbors have been helped into more secure housing. With your help this year through BottleDrop, over \$5000 has been donated to Family Promise of Greater Washington County. This would be a great time for you to collect all those refundable bottles and cans in your house/garage and bring them to St. Juan Diego to be recycled. Let's see if we can make it to \$7000 before the year ends. One woman started the ball rolling. You can now help keep the momentum growing, one can at a time.

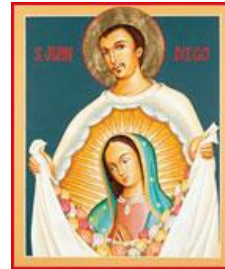
