February 8th is the International Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking. The day is to raise awareness and encourage reflection on the violence and injustice that affects the numerous victims of trafficking. Pope Francis reflected that human trafficking affects everyone. "How I wish that all of us would hear God's cry: 'Where is your brother?' (Gen 4:9). Where is your brother or sister who is enslaved? Where is the brother and sister whom you are killing each day in clandestine warehouses, in rings of prostitution, in children used for begging, in exploiting undocumented labour? Let us not look the other way. There is greater complicity than we think. 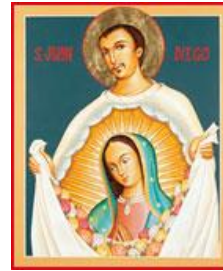


