### Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Wednesday, May 3. The Mass intention is for: **Children experiencing abuse.**

Of children today who experience abuse, 75 percent suffer neglect, 17 percent suffer physical abuse, and 8 percent suffer sexual abuse – and the majority of their abusers are related or known to the child, with nearly a quarter them being children themselves. To end those trends, we need to do more to support families, enhance parenting skills, and reduce stress among caretakers. Technology brings additional risk as predators lurk online, and children may have more unsupervised time and can be exposed to inappropriate material. Gardening for Birds with Optional Bird Hike at PCC Rock Creek Bldg. 4, Room 103 Saturday May 13 from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. Optional hike at 8:00 am

An introduction to creating a safe and supportive landscape for birds in your yard. It covers bird biology and behavior; what birds need to survive and raise their young; how best to provide food, water, and shelter; dangers to birds and how to prevent them; and resources for further learning.

Optional Bird Hike: Meet the presenter, Eric Butler, at 8am in the WCMGA Education Garden at PCC Rock Creek (just south of Building 9). Eric will lead a one-hour guided birding hike starting in the Ed Garden and then continuing to the natural area at the north end of the PCC Rock Creek campus (weather permitting). The Ed Garden has gravel paths that are easily navigated but the natural area has dirt pathways that may be a bit muddy. There is a slight downhill area for part of the path. Dress accordingly and bring binoculars if you have them!




