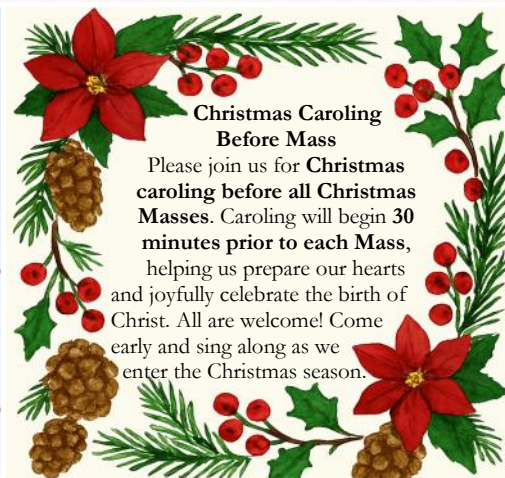

Pastoral Care Ministry/Homebound Ministry: Takes communion to the ill/aged who are no longer able to participate in the community, as well as to inpatients of Kaiser Westside Medical Center. Also provides Communion Service on Fridays for three local retirement Centers/visits Memory Care units.

Sacraments | Sacramentos: Baptism Prep for children 6 and under, Anointing of the Sick, Marriage prep are all ongoing. Sacraments for children grades 2-12 is mid-session. Our next programming is in October 2026 - registration opens up August of 2026. Adults needing Confirmation have preparation classes in April of 2026. La preparación para el bautismo para niños de 6 años o menos, la unción de los enfermos y la preparación para el matrimonio están en curso. Los sacramentos para niños de 2.º a 12.º grado se imparten a mitad de curso. Nuestra próxima programación es en octubre de 2026; la inscripción se abre en agosto de 2026. Los adultos que necesitan la confirmación tienen clases de preparación en abril de 2026.
