This attitude requires genuine spiritual maturity, of course; the kind that is cultivated by prayer, participation in the sacraments, loving attention to family and one's communion of faith, and love for one's neighbor. Are we prepared for the Lord's second coming? Are we ready to receive Christ? Are we ready to look joyously for Christ's judgment?

Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Tuesday, December 2. The Mass intention is for: **Advent Peace.**

Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, "ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus' promise to come back. But the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). ... Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

"Advent invites us to a commitment to vigilance, looking beyond ourselves, expanding our mind and heart in order to open ourselves up to the needs of people, of brothers and sisters, and to the desire for a new world." Pope Francis. <https://www.usccb.org/prayer-worship/liturgical-year/advent>

El Adviento (de "ad-venire" en latín, "venir"), que da inicio al año litúrgico de la Iglesia, abarca los cuatro domingos (y días laborables) previos a la celebración de la Navidad.

El Adviento es un tiempo de preparación que dirige nuestros corazones y mentes hacia la segunda venida de Cristo al final de los tiempos y al aniversario del nacimiento de Nuestro Señor en Navidad. Desde los inicios de la Iglesia, la promesa del regreso de Jesús ha fascinado a la gente. Pero las lecturas bíblicas de Adviento nos instan a no perder el tiempo con predicciones. El Adviento no se trata de especulaciones. Nuestras lecturas de Adviento nos llaman a estar alerta y preparados, no agobiados ni distraídos por las preocupaciones de este mundo (Lc 21,34-36). ... El Adviento también incluye un elemento de penitencia, en el sentido de preparar, aquietar y disciplinar nuestros corazones para la plena alegría de la Navidad.

Creation Corner

Cut Back on Plastic by Figuring Out How Much You Use and Why

The plastics problem is overwhelming. There's so much of it overflowing landfills and littering waterways and a lot of it can't or won't be recycled. The most effective thing you can do to cut back on plastic is to figure out how much you use. Go room by room – bathroom, bedroom, kitchen, living room – and do an audit of the plastics in your home. (Don't forget to check the trash!). Not only will this help you understand how much plastic you use, but *how* you're using it. That way, you can make a plan for how to cut back. Are you using a bottle of body wash? Replace it with a bar of soap. Bring your own tote bags for groceries instead of packing your goods in plastic bags, or your favorite reusable mug to your local coffee shop.

Reduce el plástico: descubre cuánto usas y por qué

El problema del plástico es abrumador. Hay muchísimo plástico que desborda los vertederos y ensucia los cursos de agua, y una gran parte no se puede o no se quiere reciclar. Lo más efectivo para reducir el plástico es descubrir cuánto usas. Revisa cada habitación (baño, dormitorio, cocina, sala) y haz un inventario de los plásticos en tu casa. (¡No olvides revisar la basura!). Esto no solo te ayudará a comprender cuánto plástico usas, sino también cómo lo usas. Así, podrás planificar cómo reducirlo. ¿Usas una botella de gel de ducha? Reemplázala por una pastilla de jabón. Lleva tus propias bolsas de tela para la compra en lugar de empaquetar tus productos en bolsas de plástico, o tu taza reutilizable favorita a la cafetería de tu barrio.

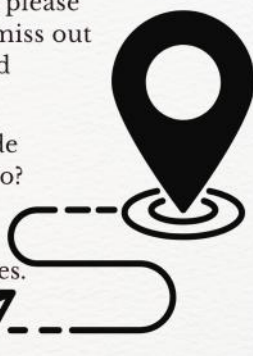
