Saint Augustine, a doctor of the church, once wrote that he first, second, and third most important attitude in Christianity is humility. In today's second reading, Saint Paul is concerned with how we conduct ourselves in our community of faith. He urges us to let our conduct be worthy of the Gospel we say that we believe; and that it all begins with humility. He asks us to consider others better than ourselves, and to serve them by looking out for their best interest, not ours. Consider how Saint Paul's appeal to imitating Christ's humility can enhance your relationships.

Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Tuesday, September 29. The Mass intention is for: Climate Refugees.

What is the connection between migration and environmental degradation?

Although we often hear of the role that political, religious, and other forms of persecution have in the displacement of persons around the world, much less attention is generally paid to environmental degradation and climate change and how that also leads to displacement. Such environmentally-linked displacement can occur due to an immediate environmental event – like a hurricane or an earthquake – or could be due to slow onset environmental change, such as a drought or rising sea levels that inundate low-lying coastal regions. With climate change likely to get worse, we can expect to see more climate-related refugees and displacement of people.... Saint Paul VI noted that “man is suddenly becoming aware that by an ill-considered exploitation of nature he [man] risks destroying it and becoming in turn the victim of this degradation.”³ Pope Benedict who, due to his work on environmental protection, has been referred to as the “green pope,”⁴ emphasized the extent to which our ability to become fully human and thrive as persons is directly linked to our relationship with the environment⁵, and expressed concern about the tragic situation confronting “environmental refugees.”⁶ Pope Francis reiterated the importance of supporting individuals affected by climate change and environmental damage when he lamented the “tragic rise in the number of migrants seeking to flee from the growing poverty caused by environmental degradation. They are not recognized by international conventions as refugees; they bear the loss of the lives they have left behind, without enjoying any legal protection whatsoever.”

¿Cuál es la relación entre la migración y la degradación ambiental? Aunque a menudo oímos hablar del papel que desempeñan la persecución política, religiosa y de otras índoles en el desplazamiento de personas en todo el mundo, por lo general se presta mucha menos atención a la degradación ambiental y al cambio climático, y a cómo estos factores también provocan desplazamientos. Este tipo de desplazamiento vinculado al medio ambiente puede producirse a raíz de un evento ambiental inmediato —como un huracán o un terremoto— o deberse a cambios ambientales de evolución lenta, como una sequía o el aumento del nivel del mar que inunda regiones costeras de baja altitud. Dado que es probable que el cambio climático se agrave, cabe esperar un aumento del número de refugiados climáticos y de los desplazamientos de personas.

Creation Corner

Season of Creation – Living Water, Week 4

Water usage affects water quality

The past two weeks we have talked about outdoor water and how trash and other contaminants can enter our watershed and decrease water quality. This week, let's take a look at our home water usage. As we previously discussed, water quality and the health of our watershed are impacted by what enters the watershed. Overuse of water resources can also threaten water quality.

In general, about 70% of household water is used indoors, with the majority of that being used in the bathroom. Your water bill is likely based on the number of CCFs you use. A CCF is a hundred cubic feet. CCFs can be converted to gallons by using this formula: Multiply CCFs x 748.0519. Divide the number of gallons used by the number of days in your billing cycle to determine, on average, how many gallons of water used each day. Common indoor water quality mistakes include ignoring leaks, using outdated fixtures, improper waste disposal, nutrient pollution, and wasteful behavior. What can you do?

- Check for leaks in your toilets by adding a few drops of food coloring to the toilet tank, wait 20 minutes and look for color in the toilet bowl. If color is present, then you have a leaky flap and it's time to replace it.
- Replace old toilets. They can use up to 6 gallons of water per flush. On average, WaterSense certified toilets use a mere 1.28 gallons per flush.
- Replace old shower heads with WaterSense certified shower heads which can save as much as 2,700 gallons of water per year.
- Eliminate laundry and dish detergents containing phosphates.

Check your water company for rebates on toilets, washing machines, and more. Also check for free residential water efficiency items like faucet aerators and shower heads.

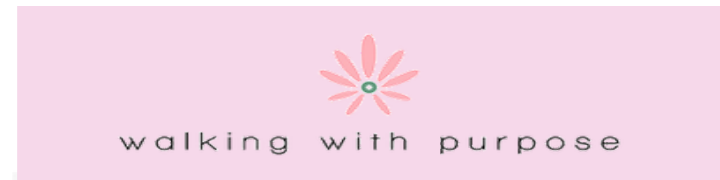
First Image GALA 2026
