A Stewardship Moment

There is an interesting twist we find in today's gospel when we hear Jesus' parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector praying in the temple. The Pharisee is "praying to himself." It doesn't mean he was praying silently. It seems to mean something a lot more troubling, that he is praying to himself; that God is not his prayer's intended audience. The words of the Pharisee are very much centered on himself: he makes claims about his character. He highlights his own admirable activities. Good stewards of their prayer lives know that a prayer of praise and thanksgiving should focus on the goodness of God. Do your prayers of thanksgiving always stay focused on God's unfathomable, immeasurable goodness and generosity?

El fariseo está "orando para sí mismo." Esto no significa que estaba orando silenciosamente. Parece significar algo mucho más preocupante, que él oraba por sí mismo; que Dios no era la audiencia a quien él dirigía su oración. Las palabras del fariseo están mucho más centradas en sí mismo: él hace exclamaciones acerca de su carácter. Enfatiza sus propias actividades admirables. Los buenos corresponsables de su vida de oración saben que la oración de alabanza y agradecimiento debe enfocarse en la bondad de Dios. ¿Están sus oraciones de agradecimiento siempre centradas en la insondable e inmensa bondad y generosidad de Dios?

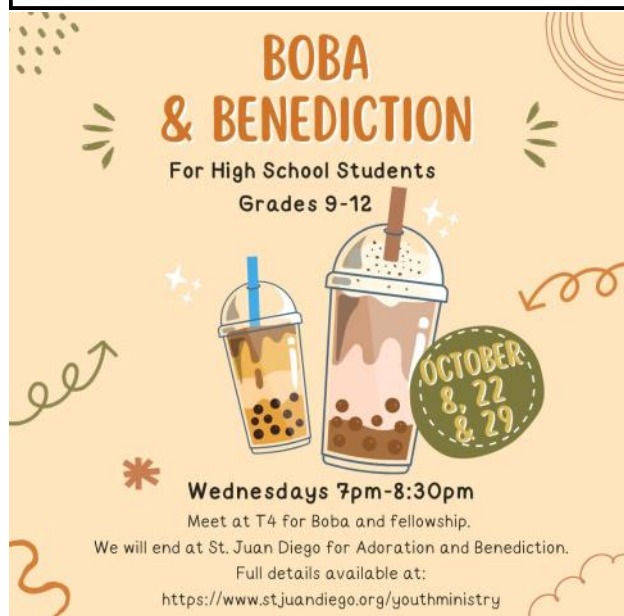

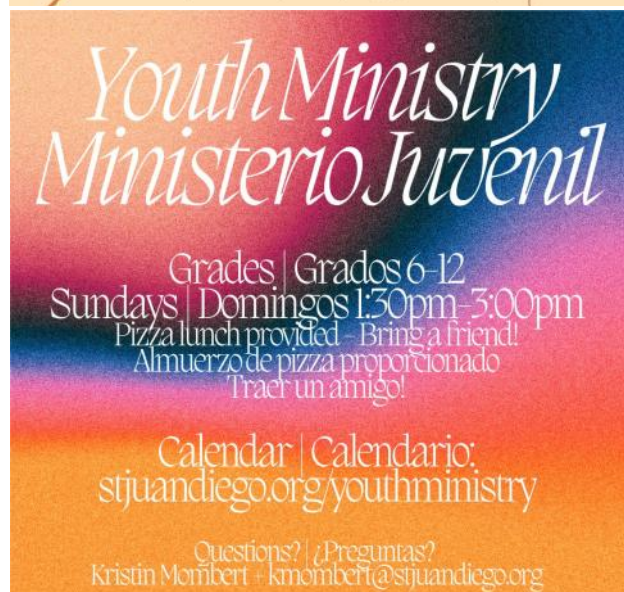

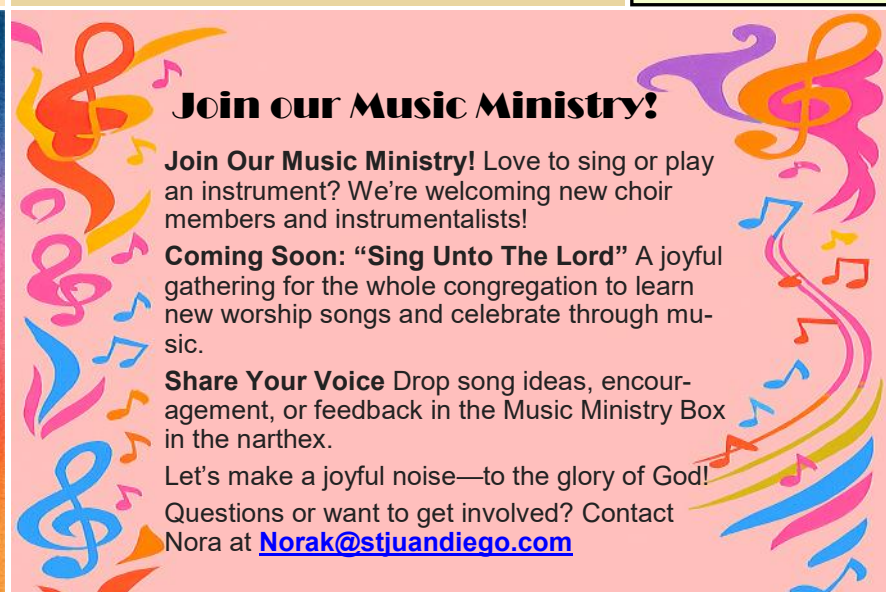

Each year the International Year of Older persons is celebrated on October 1st.

At the beginning of the twentieth century, one in every twenty-five people in the United States was 65 or older. Today one in eight—a total of 33.2 million Americans—is at least 65. A person who reaches 65 can expect to live for seventeen more years; many live well beyond that....

We are all growing older, not just as individuals but as members of a faith community. The spiritual growth of the aging person is affected by the community and affects the community. Aging demands the attention of the entire Church. Hoy, una de cada ocho —un total de 33,2 millones de estadounidenses— tiene al menos 65 años. Una persona que llega a los 65 años puede esperar vivir diecisiete años más; muchos viven mucho más.

Todos estamos envejeciendo, no solo como individuos, sino como miembros de una comunidad de fe. El crecimiento espiritual de la persona mayor se ve afectado por la comunidad y la afecta. El envejecimiento exige la atención de toda la Iglesia. Creation Corner

Tips to Save Water - Good for the planet. Good for your wallet.

1. Check your toilet for leaks at least once per year. Toilet leaks are very common and can waste hundreds to thousands of gallons of water a month. See a "How To" guide here: <https://www.regionallh2o.org/water-conservation/indoor-water-conservation/toilet#/Toilet%20Leaks>

2. Save water where you use the most: in the bathroom. WaterSense products must use at least 20% less water and work as well or better than standard fixtures/conventional products.

3. Install water-efficient aerators on your home faucets. An aerator saves water by reducing the water flow from the faucet and using air to maintain good water pressure.

4. Save water and energy when you shower. WaterSense showerheads use at least 20% less water each time you shower. You can also save up to 75 gallons a month by shortening your daily shower time by just one minute. Using less water means you'll use less energy too.
