Stewardship Moment

First Sunday of Lent. In today's Gospel, Jesus urges his listeners to do two things: to believe in the Good News and to repent. Stewards are called to repent, to be humble enough to open their hearts so they may begin anew, to change existing attitudes and habits, and to act with faith in the Gospel. In this season of Lent, now is the time to ask ourselves whether or not we truly believe in the Gospel; and if we do, to what extent are we willing to change our prevailing habits and be more faithful to the Gospel?

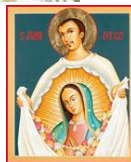

40 Cans for Lent program

We are asking that over the course of these 40 days of Lent that each family donate 40 cans of food. There will be a large barrel in the narthex to deposit your cans. It's helpful if there are many cans that you bring them in a strong bag or box.

The food pantry is in most need of the following items: cereal, peanut butter, canned pears, soup (especially chicken noodle and cream of mushroom); spaghetti noodles, spaghetti sauce, bottled juice and refried beans. Please no canned beans or expired foods.

The Knights are asking parish members to think and pray about assisting us in helping to feed the hungry. This is an easy yet vital program in which to participate and also very rewarding as the food goes directly to the needy in our community.

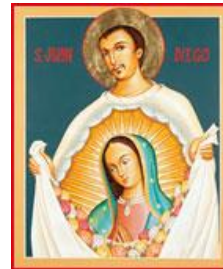
