Another option is to bring the blessed palms to church for disposal. A basket will be available for your palms on the weekends of the Ascension (June 1) and Pentecost (June 8).

Refresh the Dishwasher with White Vinegar

If a dishwasher smells funky, bacteria is usually the culprit. White vinegar can help with that! Pour 2 cups into a dishwasher-safe bowl, place it on the top rack, and run a cycle.


