A Stewardship Moment

In today's gospel reading the Twelve hear Jesus speak these words: "Whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." This is the first time Matthew mentions the word "cross" in his Gospel, and it is not in direct reference to Jesus' crucifixion but as a prerequisite to following him. Good stewards recognize that the call to discipleship requires them to "take up the cross" and align their goals in life and their fate with that of Jesus, that is, with suffering, opposition, resistance and even death. Reflect this week on the crosses you need to take up daily in order to comprehend the way of Jesus Christ.

Un Momento de Corresponsabilidad

En el Evangelio de hoy que lee a los Doce, escuche a Jesús decir estas palabras: "el que no toma su cruz y me sigue no es digno de mí". Esta es la primera vez que Mateo menciona la palabra "cruz" en su evangelio, y no es en referencia directa a la crucifixión de Jesús, sino como un requisito previo para seguirlo. Los buenos corresponsables reconocen que el llamado al discipulado requiere que "tomen la cruz" y alineen sus metas en la vida y su destino con las de Jesús, es decir, con sufrimiento, oposición, resistencia e incluso la muerte. Reflexione esta semana en las cruces que debe tomar diariamente para comprender el camino de Jesucristo.

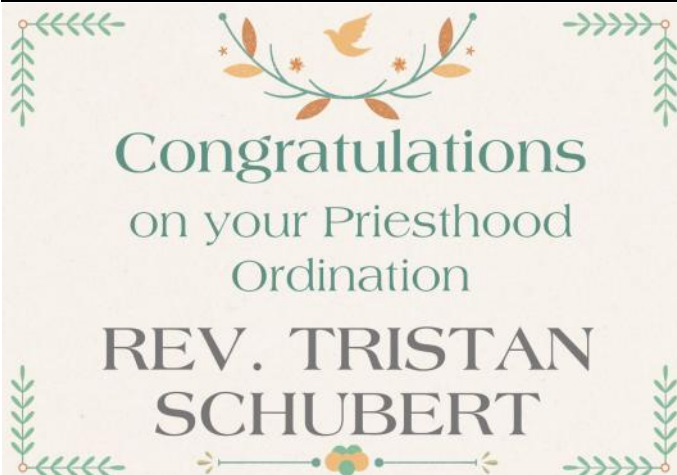

Social Justice Mass Intention

You are invited to attend and pray on Tuesday, June 30. The Mass intention is for: **Migrant workers supporting loved ones abroad.**

Every person has an equal right to receive from the earth what is necessary for life—food, clothing, shelter. Moreover, every person has the right to education, medical care, religion, and the expression of one's culture. In many places people live in fear, danger, or dehumanizing poverty. Clearly, it is not God's will that some of his children live in luxury while others have nothing. In Luke's Gospel, the rich man was condemned for living well while the poor man starved at his doorstep (Lk 16:19-31).... The native does not have superior rights over the immigrant. Before God all are equal; the earth was given by God to all. When a person cannot achieve a meaningful life in his or her own land, that person has the right to move. The act of migrating to support loved ones abroad as a fundamental right rooted in human dignity. It acknowledges that sending remittances is an act of deep sacrificial love but simultaneously warns of the severe emotional and spiritual tolls that family separation inflicts. Intenciones del Ministerio de Justicia Social

Está invitado a asistir y orar en la misa del martes 30 de junio. La intención de la misa es por: **Trabajadores migrantes que mantienen a sus seres queridos en el extranjero.**

Toda persona tiene el mismo derecho a recibir de la tierra lo necesario para la vida: alimento, vestido y vivienda. Además, toda persona tiene derecho a la educación, a la atención médica, a la religión y a la expresión de su propia cultura. En muchos lugares, las personas viven con miedo, en peligro o en una pobreza deshumanizadora. Claramente, no es la voluntad de Dios que algunos de sus hijos vivan en el lujo mientras otros no tienen nada. En el Evangelio de Lucas, el hombre rico fue condenado por vivir holgadamente mientras el pobre moría de hambre a su puerta (Lc 16:19-31). El nativo no posee derechos superiores a los del inmigrante. Ante Dios, todos son iguales; la tierra fue dada por Dios a todos. Cuando una persona no puede alcanzar una vida digna en su propia tierra, tiene derecho a emigrar. El acto de migrar para sustentar a los seres queridos en el extranjero constituye un derecho fundamental arraigado en la dignidad humana. Este principio reconoce que el envío de remesas es un acto de profundo amor sacrificial, pero advierte simultáneamente sobre el severo costo emocional y espiritual que conlleva la separación familiar. How You Can Help Butterflies

Because of their complex life cycles and interdependent relationships with plants, butterflies are especially vulnerable to habitat loss, toxins, invasive species and climate change. Over the past century in the U.S., vast areas of meadow and grassland butterfly habitats have been converted for housing, agriculture and industrial development, leaving many species in isolated pockets. Climate change has also been linked to butterfly population declines, for instance by altering the seasonal availability of host plants on which caterpillars depend.

Garden products like pesticides and fungicides can harm wildlife — not just garden pests — and pollute the environment. Eliminate use of these products. Rincón de la Creación

Cómo puede ayudar a las mariposas

Debido a sus complejos ciclos de vida y a sus relaciones interdependientes con las plantas, las mariposas son especialmente vulnerables a la pérdida de hábitat, las toxinas, las especies invasoras y el cambio climático. Durante el último siglo en los Estados Unidos, vastas áreas de praderas y pastizales que servían de hábitat para las mariposas se han transformado para el desarrollo de viviendas, la agricultura y la industria, dejando a muchas especies aisladas en pequeños espacios. El cambio climático también se ha relacionado con la disminución de las poblaciones de mariposas, ya que puede alterar la disponibilidad estacional de las plantas hospederas de las que dependen las orugas para sobrevivir.

Los productos para el jardín, como pesticidas y fungicidas, pueden dañar la vida silvestre —no solo a las plagas del jardín— y contaminar el medio ambiente. Evite el uso de estos productos siempre que sea posible. 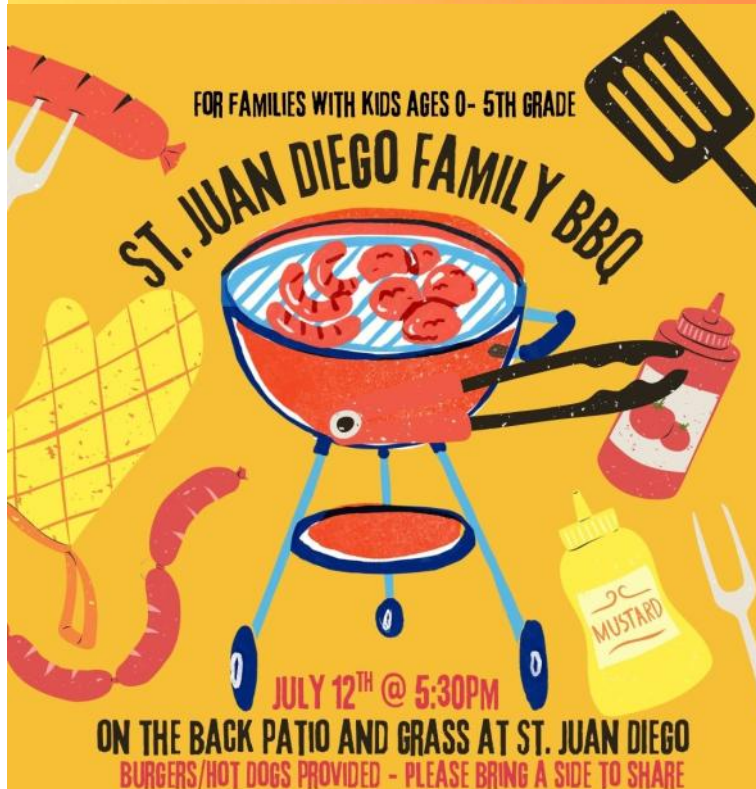
